In Christian ministry, music can serve as a medium for encouragement, worship, and even evangelism.

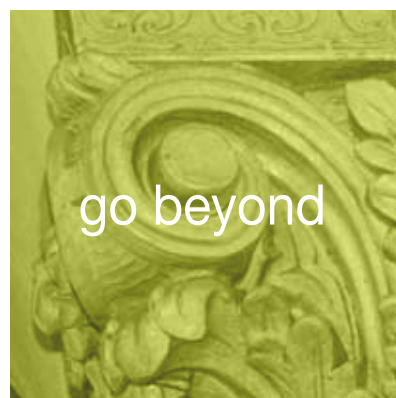

BUILD SKILLS

We give you a strong foundation to understand and apply biblical truth through 42 hours of Bible and theology courses. A required set of General Studies courses supplements that foundation and enables you to consider the world in which you will minister. You will then build on this foundation with over 40 credit hours studying the specific disciplines of your field and determining how you can best apply your unique strengths, gifts, and abilities in the many arenas of music ministry.

BBC offers you three options: Church Music (five-year), Music Ministries (four-year), or a Minor in Music. You'll have ample opportunity for hands-on experience as you participate in BBC's One Accord, Chamber Singers, or Concert Chorale, all of which appear off-campus in concert tours. You can also apply your education by becoming involved in local church music ministries.

Prepare for the future

Graduates of the five-year **Church Music** program earn both a Bachelor of Science in Bible and a Bachelor of Sacred Music.

Graduates of the four-year **Music Ministries** program complete coursework for a double major in Bible and Church Music, and are awarded a B.S. in Bible. A Minor in Music can be added to another undergraduate program to give you an introduction to music appreciation, performance, and ministry.

Our Music Ministries program will prepare you for a music pastoral position, or for music ministry on the mission field. Many graduates of BBC's music programs become private studio teachers, professional conference musicians, conductors, and composers, and have continued their education at graduate schools across the country. A few graduate schools to which our students have been accepted are Westminster Choir College, Temple University, and Eastern Michigan University.
