High School Dual Enrollment

Dual enrollment is a program that allows high school students (juniors, and seniors) to enroll in college courses for credit prior to high school graduation. College credits earned through dual enrollment can be simultaneously applied toward high school and college graduation and can be transferred to other colleges or universities. All dual enrollment courses are equivalent to on-campus courses in terms of syllabi and instructor qualifications.

What are the benefits of dual enrollment?

The benefits of dual enrollment are numerous.

- Dual enrollment allows students to transition from high school to college easily. Students can get a taste of what college is like without being completely overwhelmed with a whole new environment.
- Dual enrollment also provides high school students with a wider range of courses so they have the opportunity to explore different fields before declaring a major.
- Better preparation for what lies ahead. Confronting the challenge of college coursework will provide you with the knowledge, skills, and work habits that employers and colleges frequently ask for in their applicants.
- Finally, one of the biggest benefits of dual enrollment is that it allows students to accumulate credits toward high school graduation requirements and at the same time earn college credits prior to entering college so they will be able to graduate from college early or on time.

Who is eligible for dual enrollment?

Students should meet the requirements set by their local school system and Baptist Bible College. Baptist Bible College requires that high school dual enrollment students meet the following:

- Have a 3.0 grade point average in high school classes
- Be motivated and mature and exhibit a high level of responsibility in accomplishing designated tasks. It is expected that students will spend at least 10-12 hours/week for each online course.

What is the class format?

Dual enrollment courses are offered in both an online and on-campus format. Students taking classes online are responsible for securing adequate computer hardware, software, and internet access as prescribed by the online program at BBC.

What is the cost of dual enrollment classes?

Dual enrollment students pay only \$345 for three-credit courses.

However, dual enrollment courses are often supported by a PA Department of Education grant to partner high schools, helping to decrease the cost of our tuition rate, which is already discounted for students in the program. The grant amount can differ from student to student, depending upon a number of factors. In addition, the price of textbooks will vary from one course to the next. As a result, it is difficult for us to state that precise cost for each high school student. You should check with your guidance counselor, who will have more information.

Scholarship

Any high school dual-enroll student who attends and graduates from BBC will have 100% of high school dual enrollment tuition reimbursed in the form of a scholarship.
